

## burn FINANCIAL PLAN AT A GLANCE

The Hepburn Shire Council publishes a 10-year Financial Plan to support its Community Vision and Council Plan. Revenues over the period are forecast to increase from \$37.56M to \$45.90M

- \$37.56M in total operating revenue in 2021/2022
- \$33.30M in operating expenditure (excluding depreciation)
- •\$9.36M in capital projects
- \$22.03M in rates and charges (increasing with CPI)
- \$6.68M in borrowings 2021/2026 to support capital expenditure
- 176 full time equivalent staff in 2021/2022
- Average 2.0% increase on rates (1.5% in 2021/2022 budget)
